

Vaccination & Immunization Policy

Students who participate in clinical experiences are at risk for exposure to and possible transmission of vaccine-preventable diseases. Maintenance of immunity is required in all programs.

To protect students, healthcare providers, and patients, students must provide evidence of adequate immunity. Documentation of current immunizations and proof of current CPR certification are required.

Failure to provide the required documentation may result in withdrawal from courses and/or program.

Immunization requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Tuberculosis,
2. Tetanus
3. Diphtheria & Pertussis (Tdap)
4. Varicella, Measles
5. Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
6. Hepatitis B
7. Influenza Vaccination
